ABLE TO PROVIDE

We have seen God provide for us in some small ways and in some large ways. While at a restaurant, God gave us a free meal because our food was delivered to the wrong table. Also, having driven 1,000 miles more than I normally do before changing the oil, I asked God to work out the details for us getting it changed. At the next church on our itinerary, Madison Baptist Church, Tom Palmer asked us if we needed any work done on our van. He is in charge of a ministry that helps missionaries with vehicle repairs, shipping, and other needs. Through him, God met our need of getting our oil changed. We are constantly seeing God's provision on deputation.

ABLE TO PROTECT

On July 9, on the way to Murfreesboro, TN, we drove into some heavy storms. When we got off the interstate and stopped at the traffic light, it was hailing and our van began to shake side-to-side from the wind. We pulled into a hotel and parked under the drop-off overhang in front of the lobby. The rain was then blowing horizontal. I

told Stephanie to get out of the van and get inside. As soon as she began to open the door, the wind ripped the door open 180 degrees, causing the damage you see in the picture. We thank the Lord for His protection.



ABLE TO PLACE

We have also seen God's sovereignty in placing us where He wants us. Over the past couple months, God has changed our plans for where we will be ministering in Moldova. Instead of working in the evangelistic camp ministry and Bible Institute, God has burdened us to start churches in the northern region of Moldova. All of the current independent Baptist missionaries in Moldova live within 45 minutes from the capital of Moldova, but there is a great need for church planting up north, too.

A couple weeks ago, God placed me in a providential appointment. I had the privilege of sharing the Gospel with a Hindu named Bobby. He has been working the past six months to buy a business but without any success. He asked many questions and had a sincere desire for the truth. Pray for Bobby to trust in Christ as His Savior.

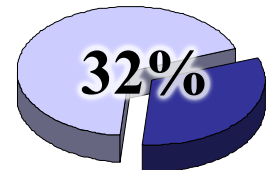
